ADRA HUNGARY'S BRIEF ANNUAL REPORT

Report for 2021

The number of beneficiaries of our relief activities has decreased by roughly a third compared to 2020, while the number of beneficiaries of our development programs has increased five times as much. This is explained, on the one hand, by the fact that - although the Covid-19 pandemic was still dominant in 2021 - coexistence with the virus and adaptation to the consequences of the situation brought a reduction in our relief activity. The other trend is the fundamental development of the Foundation's activities, which we intend to strengthen in the future.

Our key activities

NSTITUTION-DEVELOPMENT

We equipped the Dankó Pista Kindergarten, Primary School, Gymnasium, Vocational Gymnasium, Technical School, Vocational School and College Educational Center in Biri, as well as the Bocskai István Primary School in Biharkeresztes and the associated Petőfi Sándor School in Bojt with school furniture from the Netherlands. Our partner in the program was the Tiszavidék Conference of the Seventh-day Adventist Church Hungarian Union. With the program, we were able to improve the school environment for approximately 500 students.



2. Assistancet

In addition to individuals' and families' applications for assistance, we also received applications from partner organizations. We delivered food packages to 7 small settlements. We also helped with fundraising in individual life situations, and at the end of the year we delivered 1,513 shoe boxes to those in need.

3. CHILD PROTECTION PROGRAM

In order to protect children, we held a conflict management training for the staff of the Dunakanyari Család- és Gyermekjóléti Center. During our regular summer camp, we provided welfare programs for 63 children in need, with the goal of providing recreation to children and also passing values that help them cope with everyday challenges.



4. CATCH-UP SETTLEMENTS PROGRAM

From 1 July 2021 ADRA Hungary became one of the implementers of a complex settlement development program coordinated by Magyar Máltai Szeretetszőlgálat (Hungarian Maltese Charity Service). In the village of Bojt in Hajdú-Bihar County, two of our employees started the work aiming the conscious and efficient use of local resources, which serves the long-term and sustainable development of the settlement. Our staff pays special attention to children and young people in the program. The implementation is based on a settlement diagnosis made on the basis of an extensive survey.



6. Breath of life program

Although the pandemic in 2021 limited us to teach the basic resuscitation protocol in educational institutions, there was a demand for organizing trainings. We held trainings for:

- the students at the Adventist Theological College,

- the staff and foreign students of the College of the Hungarian University of Agricultural and Life Sciences in Gödöllő,

- the 10th grade students of the Szegedi Kis István Református Ģimnázium, Technikum, Általános Iskola, Óvoda és Kollégium,

- the students at the primary school Schéner Mihály Általános Iskola in Medgyesegyháza,

- the employees of Municipality of Baja From donations collected at our summer Charity concert in Baja, we donated a semi-automatic defibrillator to the city, which will be placed in the resort area.

5. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

At the beginning of 2021, a team of specialists was sent twice to the site of the earthquake in Croatia to help the victims with post-disaster recovery work. Besides the physical support, we raised € 3,400 and transferred the amount to the local ADRA office, which contributed to the construction of lightweight houses for families whose homes could no longer

To help the victims of the summer tornado in the Czech Republic, we supported ADRA Czech with an amount of € 2,000.

7. LIVING WATER PROGRAM

In Transcarpathia approximately 80-100 thousand people live without piped water supply or direct water supply. Our water network development program had been continued and 4 more wells were drilled in 2021. This means a relief for app. 200 people. The program is implemented by the Transcarpathian ADRA Office with the special donations received by ADRA Hungary.
