ADRA HUNGARY'S BRIEF ANNUAL REPORT

2020

MAIN PROGRAMS IMPLEMENTED IN 2020

There is no person, organization or government whose activities haven't been assigned by Covid-19 pandemia. ADRA Hungary's case wasn't any different, but we did our best to find our mission in the changed situation.

Breath of life

Our educational-development program had been started in 2019 and 24 instructors had participated troughout the country.

At the beginning of 2020 we started with the instructors' training and holding BLS trainings in high schools, where 170 students acquired the basic resuscitation.

We then promoted the protocol appropriate for the virus situation by publishing instructional videos.

2. #quarantinecourier

Our program has evolved in two directions.

- a) Our volunteers helped out the elderly and chronically ill patients with shopping and purchasing medicine.
- b) We distributed aid packages for families encountering difficulties.
 The packages valued 3000 HUF each and consisted of durable food and hygienic items.







560 families benefited from such packages using up the donations collected for this program.

We cooperated with "Idetartozunk Egyesület" and helped to deliver food packages to 2000 families.

3. #studyathome

The lockdown period and the digital schooling was a big challenge to many families as they hadn't possessed any IT tools to connect.

Within this program we provided portable computers to educational institutions.

The computers got to families in need after signing a loan agreement with the schools their children attend.

80 students were the beneficiaries of this program. After the digital

schooling is over, the computers will get back to the schools, where they will be part of the IT tool park - thus allowing the institution to operate at a higher level.



The **port explosion in Beirut** in August 2020 left tens of thousands of people homeless. By donating the \$ 4,300 raised during our fundraising campaign, we contributed to the reconstruction programs of the local ADRA office.

At the end of December 2020, neighboring Croatia was shaken by an earthquake. We supported the stakeholder-based programs with € 1,600.

Thanks to ADRA's global network we supported not only the emergency-response programs and the reconstruction efforts, but also supported the recovering of the local economy as the local use of the donations had a beneficial effect on this, as well

4. "Living water" program

Approximately 80 000 – 100 000 people live in Transcarpathia without piped water supply or direct water supply.

We were able to continue our water network development program with

the help of a special fundraising campaign: the ADRA running team participated at the 35th Budapest Spar Marathon. Our runners used this performance to raise awareness of the needs. The donations collected were enough to drill 3 wells, making life easier for 15 households.





5. Shoeboxes for X-mas

In 2020 Christmas gifts were perhaps more important than before, as more people were in a difficult situation due to the pandemia.

Due to the donations of Blythswood Care organization, we were able to deliver 1828 boxes to both children and adults
